LOCATION

The Manzanar Airstrip: Located on US 395, 10 miles north of the city of Lone Pine at the Manzanar Reward street sign (on the right, may be hard to see at night), go 1/4 mile east and you're there.

ELIGIBILITY

MUST BE 18 years of age and hold a valid driver's license. SCCA membership is required, weekend membership is available for \$15.

SAFETY

COMMON SENSE! - MUST WEAR SEAT BELTS AND HELMET (some loaners available). Helmets must be Z90 or any year SNELL. **No DOT helmets.** All modified and prepared category open cars must have an adequate roll bar. Roll bars recommended for all open cars. **NO alcoholic beverages or other intoxicants may be used by drivers, crew or spectators during each day's event;** after the course is closed - have a BLAST! 5 mph speed limit in pits.

CAR PREPARATION / CLASSIFICATION

CAR PREP/CLASSING: SOLO, Club Racing, SCCA, IMSA, VINTAGE, the family sled, or whatever. We will find a class for you. 5 or more drivers who want to run their own class may do so (commonly known as rent-a-racer). OPEN EXHAUST if your class allows it. Car classification will be per the 2009 SCCA National Solo rule book and CSCC Sup Regs. Still not sure what class? - provide details on how your car is prepared on the entry form (engine, suspension, tires & wheels, etc.) and we'll find a place for you. Unsafe vehicles will be turned away. This is not an autocross event, this is a high speed time trial.
