The Diaz Lake Recreational Area is located 3 miles south of Lone Pine on Highway 395. Diaz is a natural lake, formed when the earthquake of 1872 dropped the floor of the Owens Valley an estimated 20 feet. The lake offers anglers year-round fishing for bass, catfish and rainbow trout. For the sportsmen in the crowd, Diaz Lake holds an annual Trout Derby the first Saturday in March. Water sports abound as well, water skiing, jet skiing, sail boating and swimming. For campers there are 200 camp sites that are located under beautiful groves of cottonwood and willow trees. Facilities also include picnic tables, fire rings, restrooms, a shower and a playground.
